TRUSTEE ELECTIONS

A Bylaw to provide for the determination of various procedures for the conduct of general school elections and other trustee elections.

BYLAW STATEMENT

Under the *School Act*, the board of education may, by bylaw, determine various procedures and requirements to be applied in the conduct of trustee elections.

GUIDING LEGISLATION/REGULATIONS

- *School Act, Part 4*

REGULATIONS

In School District No.87 (Stikine), under *Section 45* and *37(3)* of the *School Act*, trustee elections in the following trustee electoral areas are the responsibility of the school district:

<u>Area</u>	<u>Trustee electoral area</u>	<u># of trustees</u>
A	Atlin and surrounding area	one
B	Lower Post/Good Hope Lake/Fort Ware and surrounding area	one
C	Dease Lake and surrounding area	one
D	Telegraph Creek and surrounding area	one
E	Iskut and surrounding area	one

The board of education wishes to establish various procedures and requirements under the authority of the *School Act* for trustee elections.

The board of education, in a regular meeting of the board, enacts as follows:

1. Definitions

The terms used shall have the meanings assigned by the *School Act* and the Local Government Act, except as the context indicates otherwise.

- "Election" means a trustee election
- "Board" or "school board" means the Board of Education of School District No.87 (Stikine).

2. Application

This bylaw applies to both general elections and by-elections and to those trustee elections carried out by other authorities, except as otherwise indicated.

3. Order of Names on the Ballot

The order of names of candidates on the ballot will be determined by lot in accordance with *section 107 of the Local Government Act*.

4. Second Advance Poll

A second advance voting opportunity referred to in section 107 (2) of the *Local Government Act* is not to be held for School District No. 87 (Stikine)

5. List of Voters

Pursuant to *section 64 of the Local Government Act*, the most current available Provincial list of voters prepared under the *Election Act* is the register of resident electors for School District No 87 (Stikine). The Provincial list of voters will become the register of resident electors no later than 52 days before the general voting day for any election to which this bylaw applies.

6. Public Access to Election Documents

6.1 The Board authorizes posting of nomination documents of trustee candidates on the website of School District No. 87 (Stikine) until 30 days after declaration of the election results.

6.2 The Board authorizes posting of trustee candidates' campaign financing disclosure statements and declarations and supplementary statements and declarations on the website of School District No. 87 (Stikine) until one year from general voting day.

7. Title

This bylaw may be cited as "School District No 87 (Stikine) Trustee Election Bylaw No.-101". The Bylaw is to provide for the determination of various procedures for the conduct of general school elections and other trustee elections.
